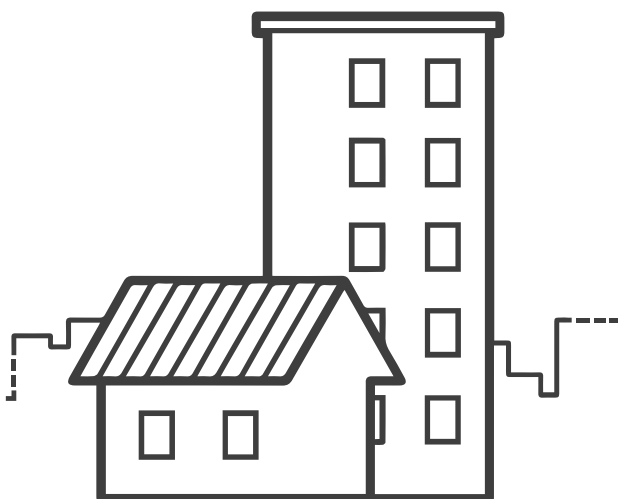

- Automatic fire detection & alarm systems (level 2)
- Automatic fire suppression systems (level 2)
- Fire dampers
- Fire hydrant systems (level 2)
- Mechanical air handling system
- Smoke & heat vents
- Smoke dampers

To pursue **Fire Safety Assessment Qualified Accreditation Pathway II** in any or all the seven fire safety measures specific to the minimum entry level of a diploma or higher, it is required to complete all the following competency units;

- **BSBAUD513** Report on quality audits
- **CPCSFS5014** Conduct annual fire systems inspections
- **CPCCBBC4012** Read and interpret plans and specifications
- **CPCSFS5015** Prepare documentation for annual fire systems inspections

Please note that it is essential to understand that achieving Fire Safety Assessment Qualified Accreditation involves meeting additional criteria beyond completing the required training units. These criteria include experience prerequisites, obtaining insurance coverage, and undergoing an evaluation by FPAA.

PROGRAM OUTLINE

Two-day - Virtual Classroom (online with a live trainer).

A virtual classroom is a digital platform designed for learning that employs a delivery format such as Zoom. Here, a live trainer facilitates online training sessions, focusing on critical course content and guiding students on how to navigate through the program. This medium enables real-time engagement through audio and video communication, allowing trainers to interact with their students as they participate in learning and assessment activities.

In addition to the live sessions, this program provides self-paced online learning, where students research, prepare and submit their assessments via the Learning Management System (LMS). Students will undertake personal study and develop fire system assessments using templates and available resources based on genuine work performances for evaluation purposes. Students' tasks require them to develop various documents, and service reports, with outcomes commonly found in the industry.

Students will complete knowledge tests at different intervals corresponding to the covered subjects. To research the answers, students can refer to the course training materials, notes, and other relevant references.

The training is structured in a logical sequence to enable a step-by-step learning process. The activities are presented in a clear manner. They are directly linked to the course and industry information, allowing assessors to ascertain that students can competently apply their knowledge and skills.

The duration of the course is flexible, with students having up to 12 months to complete it. The more time students dedicate to the online learning component, the faster they can work through the content and assessment tasks.

- Students will receive a Zoom link via email for the virtual classroom two days before the training.

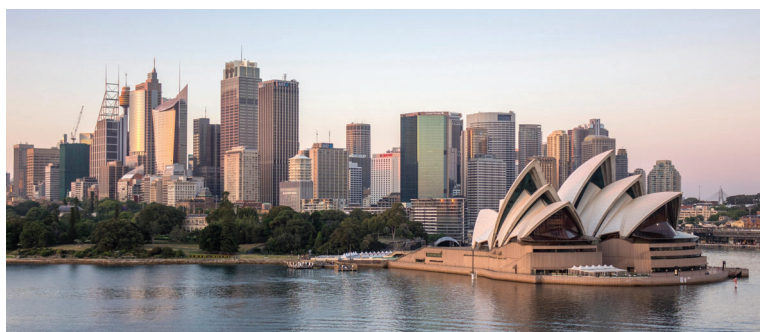
