Thank you for your interest in completing online- CPPFES2037 Inspect and test fire hydrant systems (Release 1).

This course is Nationally Recognised Training, recognised throughout Australia by industry bodies, employers, accreditation schemes, and licencing applications.

This nationally recognised Australian unit of competency applies to individuals who are or training to be fire protection technicians responsible for non-trade installation and regular servicing of fire hydrant systems.

This qualification provides fire protection technicians with the certificate to follow the pathway of licencing and accredited schemes in all states of Australia.

This course covers routine inspection and testing activities per AS1851 for six months and yearly servicing of hydrant systems, **excluding** annual functional flow testing.

Licensing/Regulatory Information

Work in this area must be completed according to relevant legislative, industry, customer, and organisational requirements.

The technician cannot undertake any functions restricted to licensed trades or occupations such as particular installation, replacement, maintenance, and repair functions.

Different states and territories may have regulatory mechanisms that apply to this training.

Students are advised to check for regulatory limitations.

Online zoom: This training requires students to participate in a **4-hour** zoom training session.

Learning Outcomes

Interpret work instructions to plan and discuss service requirements with customers

Identify hydrant systems service requirements and plan for servicing

Identify potential and actual breaches of rules and regulations for service work

Select and maintain the appropriate tools required for servicing

Identify and implement control of hazards associated with work activities

Inspect & test fire hydrant systems following six monthly and yearly AS1851 service schedules

Identify and isolate pumps and other fire system interfaces

Identify and record system defects following regulatory and workplace requirements

Record test results following regulatory and workplace requirements

Program Outline and Assessments

This course will be delivered using blended learning, which can utilise any combination of the following; one-on-one and group discussions via the Zoom platform, online workbooks, assessments, interactive templates, and video tutorials. The professionally presented reference material and resources help students develop their knowledge of the subject.

Training is sequenced to allow a logical progression.

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Course requirements

Industry-compliant service records as per **AS1851** completed 6 months prior to training, can also be submitted as evidence.

Tasks: Students will undertake a range of tasks that will require the creation of various documents, service reports, and outcomes typical in the industry.

Industry Work Performance: Records of inspection and testing activities completed on a prescribed number of sites and equipment. Some of the required work performance evidence to complete this course is as follows:

15 hydrant systems across a minimum of **10** sites.

Written Reports: Using templates and available resources, students will produce a range of written service records based on real testing and inspections for assessment.

Knowledge Test: Students will undertake knowledge tests throughout their study— progressively, as subjects are covered, completion of tests is required. Students may research the answers from the course training materials and notes, and relevant references.

Computer Skills: Students need to be familiar with electronics/computers and have the ability to use our online learning portal to access, download and upload course material for the online component of the course and complete online knowledge assessments.

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Course fee

Payment not required when enrolling; we will contact the enrollee to discuss their suitability for training and email an invoice. The payment of the invoice per student is required to secure placement

Procedure after enrolment.

- After enrolling online, we will contact the student to discuss their suitability for training.
- Enrolment confirmation will be emailed, including the invoice.
- Following the receipt of full payment, we will confirm via email, including the login details to start training.
The student will have 6 months to complete the training.
- 2 months extension available if needed: Fee applies \$100.
- Once the student has logged into our online learning platform, they can access course documentation, instructions, procedural videos & resources.
- Students will receive correspondence via email/text message containing zoom link information a few days before.
